- □ **Grooming / operations plan** the plan is still under refinement. The club hopes to groom 6 days a week, with the help of the Steamboat Lake Outpost. Our intent is to start grooming mid December ending April 1 of 2024. The club may choose to delay the start based on snow conditions. During the meeting it was expressed that the club should not groom until there is at least 5 feet of snow on the trails system. Once the plan is firmed up, the web page will contain the latest version of the grooming plan
- Rocky Mountain Sled Rentals has agreed to pay for the first 1,000 gallons of fuel
- Colorado Sled Rentals has pledged \$10,000 towards grooming
- Club work sled purchase
 - The club has a need for a work sled, something that can be used to set/pull poles, support remote maintenance activity as well as other trail maintenance tasks. Currently, the club borrows sleds from other members, the Steamboat Lake Outpost or the Steamboat Lake State park. Due to scheduling logistics, liability concerns and a demand pattern which is difficult to plan for, the club believes that they should invest in their own work sled that can support our needs.

Discussion on this topic resulted in a **MOTION** that the club procure a work sled with a not to exceed value of \$13,000. **MOTION APPROVED**

- □ Stan Wagoner agrees to take an action to talk with Steamboat Powersports to see if they can help us with a new work sled for under \$13,000
- **Volunteers for trail marking** The club intends to mark trails mid December or as snow conditions permit. Please contact us if you are interested in helping out.
- Sponsorship Renewals The club will be updating its "sponsorship" status next month. Sponsorships include listings in the clubs web pages and remain in effect through December of 2024. Sponsors may sign up by donating through the clubs website or by contacting the club directly.
- Donation Marketing The club is interested in doing a little direct marketing to solicit donations. Ron Wendler, <u>The Group Real Estate</u>, <u>Inc</u> has agreed to help the club do some targeted marketing to the 80428 zip code.
